

Canning College offers a Diploma of Commerce Curtin Stream which provides a guaranteed pathway into Year 2 of the Bachelor of Commerce degree at Curtin University and a Diploma of Commerce UWA Stream which provides a guaranteed pathway into Year 2 of the Bachelor of Commerce degree at The University of Western Australia. The Canning College Diploma of Commerce is equivalent to first year of the Bachelor of Commerce.

Features of the Diploma Courses are:

- The Diploma course has a 'core and electives' structure and is of one year's duration. It is focused on business/commerce studies.
- Eight modules need to be successfully completed to be awarded the Diploma.
- Modules are studied over two semesters, with two intakes yearly in February and July.
- The course will be conducted over two semesters (720 hours 20 hours per week for each semester) each of approximately 18 weeks duration. Each semester will consist of 13 teaching weeks, 3 tuition free/study weeks and 2 week examination period making up the 18 weeks. This may be varied from year to year.
- The course is delivered using a variety of teaching methods including lectures, tutorials, workshops and seminars.

Registration

Canning College is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO number 2047). The Diploma of Commerce is a Level Five (5) course within the Australian Qualifications Framework.



Accreditation

Canning College is a registered provider for international students (CRICOS 00463B) and a Registered Training Organisation (RTO: 2047). The Diploma of Commerce is an accredited course by Training Accreditation Council of Western Australia (TACWA).
