

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES

HOMESTAY GUIDELINES

These guidelines have been developed by Canning College for the benefits of host families and students. Any student staying in a homestay must comply with them to ensure a happy “home away from home” experience.

HOMESTAY EXPECTATIONS

- I will arrive home by 6.30 p.m. from Sunday to Thursday each week. Other times may be negotiated with the homestay host but would be no later than 7.30 p.m. On weekends, I may go out on Friday or Saturday nights but must be home by 11.00 p.m. If I am out late at night I will need to catch a taxi home, not a bus.
- I will need to inform my host family about my activities, arrival home time, other contact numbers and address of where I am going.
- **I must contact my host family and advise them if there are any changes to my plans whilst away and I must answer my mobile calls and texts from my hosts at all times.**

STAYING AWAY OVERNIGHT

- I understand that I am not permitted to stay out overnight except when given permission by my host and/or carer for special occasions. A written approval from my parents must be provided to Canning College, my homestay and AHN containing contact name, address and mobile phone details of whom I will be staying with.

FLIGHT ARRANGEMENTS

- Any travel arrangements must be confirmed, in writing by my parents. I am aware that I need to notify Canning College, my homestay and AHN. I need to include a copy of my flight tickets.

ALCOHOL AND SMOKING

- If I am under 18 years of age, I understand that it is illegal to purchase tobacco and alcohol.

QUIET TIMES

- I agree to keep noise levels to a minimum level from 10.00 pm.
- I will only use the internet (supplied in my homestay) for study purposes **not** for downloading or playing games. I can purchase my own data to utilise this type of viewing.
- I will need to avoid making or receiving phone calls after 10.00 p.m.

VISITS BY FRIENDS

- I must ask permission for my friends to visit me and they must leave at a reasonable hour (determined by my host) and not disturb other household members.

HOUSHOLD CHORES

- I understand that the homestay host may ask me to help with some small chores around the house and expect me to clean my own room.

CONSEQUENCES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE

If I do not adhere to the care arrangements, such as homestay rules, my enrolment may be cancelled.

VICKERY HOUSE GUIDELINES

Vickery House have their own guidelines, however

ALCOHOL AND SMOKING

- If I am under 18 years of age, I understand that it is illegal to purchase tobacco and alcohol.

QUIET TIMES

- I agree to keep noise levels to a minimum level from 10.00 pm.

VISITS BY FRIENDS

- I must ask permission for my friends to visit me and they must leave at a reasonable hour (determined by my peers) and not disturb other household members.

HOUSHOLD CHORES

- I understand that each resident should do chores in the common areas (kitchen, bathroom etc) around the house and I am expected to keep my room clean and tidy.

FLIGHT ARRANGEMENTS

- Any travel arrangements must be confirmed, in writing. I am aware that I need to notify Canning College and Vickery House. If under 18, a copy of my flight tickets need to be given to Student Services.

CONSEQUENCES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE

If I do not adhere to the care arrangements, such as Vickery House rules, my enrolment may be cancelled.
