

International Education Scholarship Information 2020

Canning College is offering a number of prestigious scholarships for international students to undertake the Western Australian Universities' Foundation Program (WAUFP) or Year 12 Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) program at Canning College in Perth, Western Australia (WA). Applicants from all countries will be eligible for consideration.

Scholarship winners are selected on the basis of academic results and a reference from the school. Where academic results do not allow for differentiation between applicants, resumes or curriculum vitae will be considered.

Students can nominate the scholarship to apply to:

January Entry 2020: WAUFP and WACE
April Entry 2020: WAUFP and WACE
Mid-Year Entry 2020/2021 WAUFP

Year 11 students at Canning College and other Australian schools may apply for an award on the basis of their year 11 results. (Contact the Canning College student services office – Canning.Col.Admissions@education.wa.edu.au). Canning College starts scholarship assessment after October 31. Scholarship applications received after this date will also be assessed. Applications should be submitted to the College's local authorised representative or directly to Canning at the address below.

NO APPLICATION FEE

Students will be required to complete an International Student Application Form and International Scholarship Application Form.

Additional documentation:

1. Reference from the school principal.
2. Actual or mock/forecast/preliminary results for major examinations equivalent to Year 11 in Western Australia.
3. Two (2) most recent school reports.
4. Curriculum Vitae or resume.

Scholarships are available to the value of \$10,000, \$7,000, \$5,000 and \$3,000.

These awards would normally require the student to have achieved the highest possible grade in at least **five (5) relevant** subjects.

These scholarships may be offered to students at any time, including during marketing visits. Such students must pay a non-refundable deposit of A\$1,000 within **two (2)** weeks of the offer or forfeit the scholarship offer.

Conditions

- Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit and school recommendation as judged by a selection panel of College staff. Once a scholarship is awarded, no other financial benefits (e.g. family bursary) apply.
- Scholarship students who withdraw after 4 weeks of commencement of the course forfeit any refund of fees.

Applications

Please include appropriate academic details. For example, for entry into WACE or WAUFP please attach recent academic results which equate to year 11 in Perth.

- Applicants from all countries are eligible. The following are examples only:**

Singapore, Brunei	:	'O' Levels or results of preliminary examinations equivalent to O Levels.
Malaysia	:	Forecast SPM or completed SPM; Senior Middle 2 results.
Indonesia	:	Year 11
Hong Kong	:	HKDSE or Form 5
Kenya	:	KCSE or O Levels
Zambia	:	Zambia Certificate of Education/O Levels
Zimbabwe	:	O Levels
Vietnam	:	Year 11

Include your two most recent school reports with any predicted or mock results.
