Course Credit Policy

Exemptions from units

(Credit for Recognised Learning - CRL)

Course credit policy applies to Diploma of Commerce and Certificate IV (Commerce) programs.

Diploma of Commerce UWA Stream and Curtin Stream.

Course credit is awarded by the universities concerned.

In the case of each Stream (Curtin and UWA), any application for course credit is forwarded to the Business School at the particular university. The application must include the student's academic record for any qualification to be considered.

Any credits will be noted and the student informed before enrolment is completed.

Any credit allocated by the university is recorded in the student's file and course fees adjusted as required.

Alterations to course length will be reported via PRISMS.

Certificate IV (Commerce) HEPS

Course credit is applied for and awarded through the International Office.

The application must include the student's academic record for any qualification to be considered.

Any credits will be noted and the student informed before enrolment is completed.

Any credit allocated by the college is recorded in the student's file and course fees adjusted as required.

Alterations to course length will be reported via PRISMS.
