About the scholarship

The University of Western Australia and Canning College Undergraduate Entry Excellence Awards are awarded to students who have demonstrated academic excellence and strong leadership skills in their high school studies and are enrolled in the 2018 Western Australian Universities' Foundation Program (WAUFP) at Canning College with a packaged undergraduate program at The University of Western Australia in 2019.

Award details

The successful candidates will receive the following scholarship:

Canning College Excellence Award \$10,000

Two awards are available.

Candidates must demonstrate high academic achievement and strong leadership skills.

The University of Western Australia Excellence Award \$10,000

Two awards are available.

Students must achieve a minimum CPS of 85% or higher in the WAUFP.

Students for the Canning College WAUFP component will be chosen from a selection process – see the Application Form for full details. The winners will be announced by mid-November 2017.

The University of Western Australia component will be confirmed when final WAUFP results are released in early December 2018.

The University of Western Australia Excellence Award Certificate will be presented to the awardees at a special ceremony to be held once the students have commenced their undergraduate courses at The University of Western Australia.

How to apply

Applications must be submitted using the Application Form.

Applications must include:

1. Required academic records and school reports.
2. A letter of recommendation from the school.
3. A concise curriculum vitae.

**Applications will close
31 October 2017.**

Eligibility

The Canning College Excellence Award will be awarded to students who meet the criteria below:

1. Outstanding academic achievement and ranking in a reputable secondary school.
2. Strong school leadership and community service.
3. Broad academic and cultural interests.

Students must be able to meet the Genuine Temporary Entrant requirements as outlined by the Department of Immigration and Border Protection.

The University of Western Australia Excellence Award will be awarded to the Canning College Excellence Award winner providing they meet the below criteria:

- Have achieved a minimum CPS of 85% or higher in the WAUFP program at Canning College

- Be enrolled or eligible to enrol full-time in an undergraduate degree course

Conditions

- The student must maintain a 100% load (normally 48 points) at The University of Western Australia and continue to meet the eligibility criteria requirements.
- The award is conditional on formal assessment and a written offer from the University's Admissions team in Perth.

Method of payment

- Payment of the Canning College Excellence Award will be in the form of reduced course fees for the WAUFP 2018.
- Payment of The University of Western Australia Excellence Award will be provided by the University after the census date as a fee reduction of the second semester tuition fees at the University.
