YOUR NEW STUDY CHOICE



Canning College is an Independent Public School (Department of Education, Western Australia). We offer three signature programs, the WA Curriculum and the WA Certificate of Education. Our programs provide international and local students, including those of mature age, excellent preparation for tertiary studies.

SIGNATURE PROGRAMS

Western Australian Universities' Foundation Program (WAUFP)

A two-semester course for international students and for local students who have completed less than two years of secondary school in Australia. Students in this program follow the WA Certificate of Education (WACE) syllabus in all subjects except for English. Students study English Language and Australian Cultural Studies (ELACS) for 9 hours per week.

Diploma of Commerce (The University of Western Australia Stream and Curtin University Stream)

A two-semester course that is the equivalent to the first year Bachelor of Commerce degree at UWA and Curtin University. Successful completion of the Diploma leads students into the second year of the university bachelor degree.

Certificate IV in University Access Program (UAP)

A semester-length course that prepares students for university studies and leads to many undergraduate courses at Curtin University and Murdoch University. This qualification is equivalent to a 70 Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR). The successful completion of the Certificate IV also leads into Canning College's Diploma of Commerce.

WA CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (WACE)

Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) courses in Year 11 and Year 12 with a Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) focus. The Year 11 program is designed to provide students with the knowledge and skills required for a successful transition into Year 12 studies and the achievement of an ATAR. At the successful completion of WACE ATAR, students are ready to enter university degree programs.

YEAR 10 STUDIES

Focuses on STEM and ATAR preparation. Students study English, Health and Physical Education, Humanities and Social Sciences, Mathematics and Science, enhanced by expanded learning opportunities to enrich their learning experience. Our Year 10 program provides off-campus opportunities to explore careers, engage in cultural experiences and connect with universities. The study of ethics and problem solving are built into the core curriculum.
