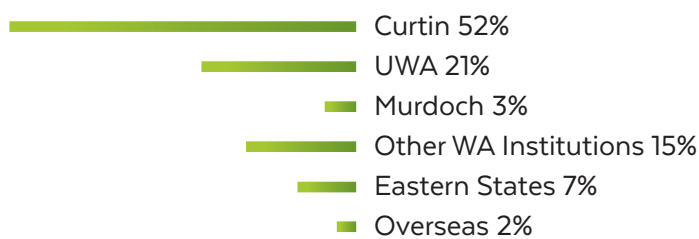

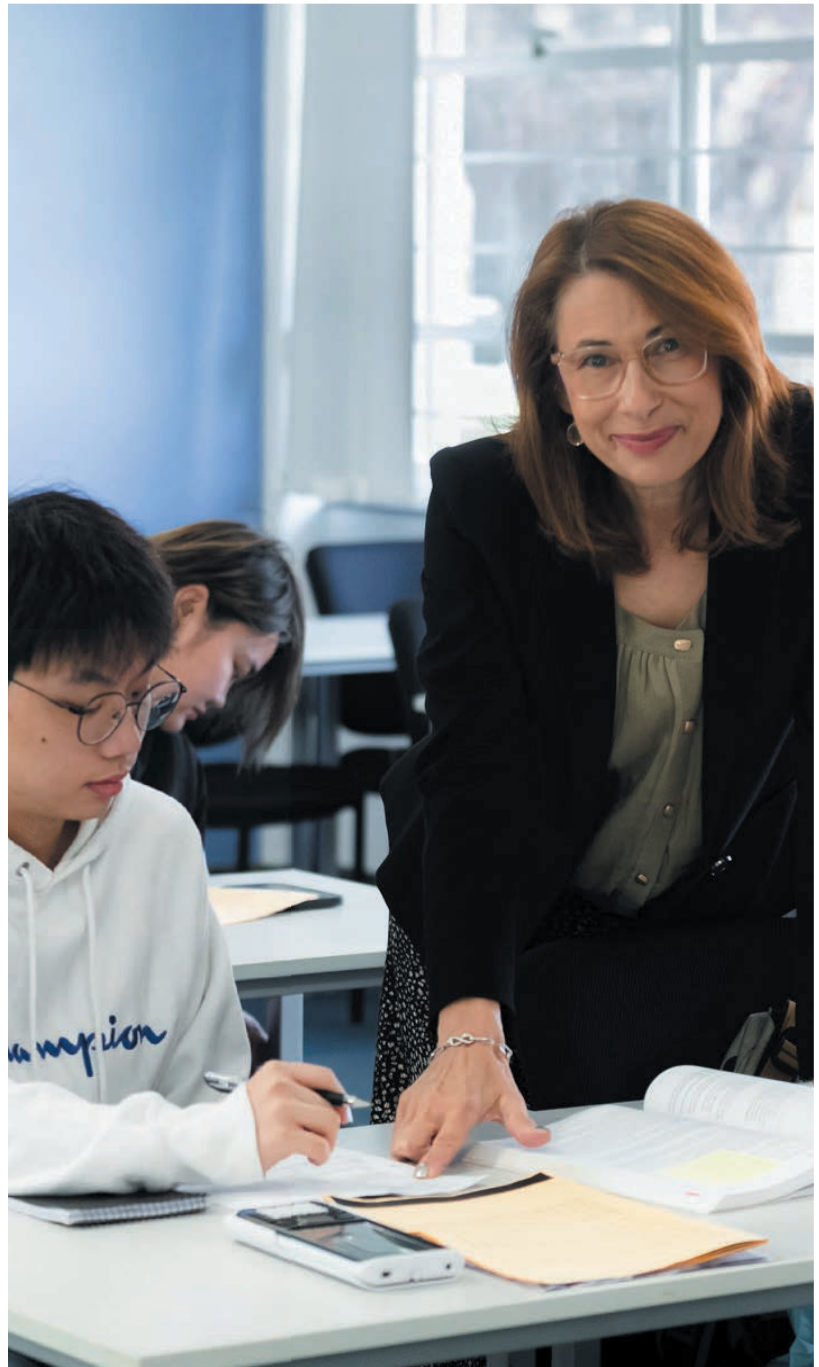

Year 11 & Year 12 WACE ATAR

The WA Certificate of Education is a nationally recognised qualification that is awarded to students who have successfully completed Year 11 and Year 12. Completion of the WACE at Canning College provides students with an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR), which is used for university entry.

Start in February or April and complete in December.
Cost: February start AUD\$23,578,
April start AUD\$18,268.

Year 10

The Year 10 program is designed to give students a pathway into senior school, and beyond senior school to university. It integrates the four major subject areas of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM), and promotes creative, independent and critical thinking.

Start in February or April and complete in December.

April start AUD\$18,268.

Bridging

Bridging programs are designed for international students who need to improve academic skills before commencing another course. The focus is on developing English language competency, but it also provides the opportunity to improve academic skills in Mathematics, Science, Business Studies, Economics and Computing. Bridging programs lead into Year 11, WA Universities' Foundation Program and Certificate IV (in UAP).

Cost: Two terms AUD\$12,536,
one term AUD\$7,359.

Student Support

Students benefit from:

- Orientation program to help students adjust quickly and make new friends.
- Specialist Student Advisors who assist with subject selection and provide advice on university destinations and degree courses, as well as matters outside of education.
- Psychologist on campus.
- Additional English language support.

Classrooms are equipped with the latest technology for expert lesson delivery. We also have computer laboratories, which allow for specialised lesson delivery. Small class sizes help students focus on their academic tasks and improve performance.

The College library has several areas for quiet study, while the student lounge and cafeteria are a hive of activity between classes.

The recreation centre, which is used for multiple sports, and the music rooms are perfect for students to take short breaks from their academic pursuits.
